CALLAWAY PUBLIC SCHOOLS AUGUST 2023 NEWSLETTER

<u>Open House:</u> Come help us celebrate back to school Wednesday, August 16, 2023 from 5:30-7:00pm. Incoming seventh graders will have orientation from 5:00-5:30pm. Please have a parent attend with the student to orientation. Meet your teachers and bring supplies. Supper will be provided. Come check out what's new at school! Back to school packets will be available for pick up.

<u>Welcome Back:</u> The first day of school for Pre-K-12 students will be on Thursday, August 17, 2023. School will start at 8:00am and end at 3:44pm for 7-12 graders and 8:05-3:44pm for K-6 students. Breakfast and lunch will be served. Buses will run their regular routes. Regular school hours for 7-12 will be 8:00am to 3:44pm, Monday through Thursday. Friday dismissals will be at 2:40pm. Elementary regular hours will be 8:05am to 3:44pm, Monday through Thursday. Friday dismissals will be at 2:40pm. Preschool age 3 will be from 8:05am to 11:05am Monday thru Friday and Preschool age 4 will be from 12:15pm to 3:44 Monday through Thursday with a 2:40 dismissal on Friday's.

Students are expected to arrive at school no more than 15-20 minutes prior to the first class or school program in which they are participating. Prior to that time, the school is not responsible for supervision of the students. The doors will remain locked until 7:30am.

<u>School Lunch Program</u>: Breakfast and lunch will be served on the first day of school for students in grades K-12. Each Student/Staff will have a 4 digit lunch code that they will need to know in order to go through the lunch line.

Lunch prices for the 2023-2024 school year will be K-6 \$2.80, 7-12 \$2.95, and Adults \$4.10. Breakfast price \$2.35. An extra carton of milk will be \$.40. Seconds for K-12 will cost an additional \$.75. An extra juice will be \$.25. Parents with Pre-school, Kindergarten and First grade students will be charged an additional \$9.00 per month for snacks.

<u>All meals should be prepaid... charges will not be accepted.</u> Payment for lunches must be made in advance. YOUR LUNCH ACCOUNT NEEDS TO BE PAID MONTHLY. IF YOU NEED TO MAKE OTHER ARRANGEMENTS, PLEASE CALL THE SCHOOL OFFICE AT 836-2272. Students cannot checkout at the end of the school year until accounts are paid in full.

FEDERAL LUNCH APPLICATION:

EVERYONE IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO FILL OUT AN APPLICATION! This will help with State funding.

If you did not receive an application or have questions filling out the application, please call the school at 836-2272. Families may apply any time during the school year. As required by law, all information is completely confidential.

<u>Student Handbook:</u> Both parents and all students in the family who are in school, should sign the form included with the handbook. High School students will be required to return all completed paperwork

before being allowed to take their chromebook home. Paperwork will be handed out on the first day of school to the youngest child in your family. All paperwork must be received by Thursday, August 24th.

<u>School Insurance</u>: Students will be also be receiving an insurance flyer the first day of school explaining the 24-hour, school-time, dental, life, and football coverage. If you would like to be covered under this policy, please follow the link on the flyer.

<u>Picture Day:</u> Picture Day will be held on August 22, 2023. A form will be sent home and only needs sent back on picture day if you need two copies of pictures.

Chromebook Loan Agreement and User's Fee:

The computer loan agreement will be part of the packet of forms and information that you receive from the school. Parents are to read and sign the agreement if you wish to have your student or students have the use of a computer in and out of school. This would be a great time to talk to your student about your expectations while they are online. Students will read and go over their part of the agreement with Mr. Keeney the first day of school; they will also sign the agreement if they would like to use the school's computer during the school year. There is a \$25 user's fee for all computers and chromebooks that are issued to students. This fee will cover the use of a computer for one school year. Callaway Public Schools has purchased software which will allow the Chromebooks to be filtered and monitored 24 hours a day. Classroom teachers will also be able to monitor the use of Chromebooks in their classrooms.

<u>Bus Notes:</u> Students not on regular routes who will be riding the bus, students transported to another stop, or town students wishing to use the school transportation must turn in a written note, from their parent or guardian, to the office to be approved prior to the time transportation is needed. Students, who do not have a note, will not be able to ride. This is in compliance with state law and school policy

<u>Locked Doors:</u> For the Safety of the students, the School Board decided to leave all doors locked during the school day. After 8:00am all doors will be locked and you must use the front doors. You will need to be buzzed into the school. Please ring the buzzer and wait for the office to let you in. All visitors are required to check in at the office.

Asbestos in the School: This notice is being written to inform you that our school district does have a limited amount of asbestos. The asbestos is located in the Jr.-Sr. High school and in the elementary building as well. The asbestos is located on thermal pipe elbows and thermal pipe joints in the gym and the locker room areas. The hot water holding tank in the boiler room has a covering that contains asbestos. All the areas mentioned are covered and in good shape. The building has been inspected and a management plan to contain or remove the asbestos has been developed and sent to the Nebraska Department of Health. The school district will go through another inspection this year to determine the condition of the asbestos as to this date. If you should have more questions concerning the asbestos plan, please feel free to discuss your concerns with the Superintendent. The asbestos management plan is located in the central office.

<u>Student Absences</u>: To help insure the safety of the students, we are asking all parents, <u>to please call</u> the school office when he/she will be absent. This will minimize time if something were to happen to the student on their way to school. We appreciate your cooperation.

<u>Lost and Found:</u> Throughout the year we get an accumulation of clothes, shoes, coats, jewelry, house keys, etc. If your child has lost or misplaced anything, please check at the main office or at the athletic office. Parents, it would also help if you put your child's name on clothing, especially coats, as we end up with an assortment at the end of the year. Any item not claimed at the end of the year, will be taken to Goodwill.

<u>2023-2024 School Physicals</u>: Students entering Kindergarten, 7th, and 9th grades or new to the school district are required to have a school physical prior to the beginning of the school year. All 7th through 12th graders who plan on participating in any activities must have a school physical completed before participating.

Concussion Baseline Testing

<u>ALL Students in grades 9-12</u> that plan to participate in a sport during the 2023-2024 school year must complete the new concussion baseline testing. South Loup Athletics is utilizing a new program for the concussion baseline testing called XLNT Brain. In order to complete the student profile, parent email addresses are needed. This will allow parents to access their child's information and recommendations if he or she ever sustained a concussion. The new program creates a hub of information and communication between trainers, coaches, parents and students. If you have any questions, please contact Heath Birkel at (308)836-2272.

A student profile must be created by the school prior to being able to complete the test. If you follow the school's Facebook page, a link is available to be completed. If you do not have access to Facebook please contact the office and we will take your information. Please provide an up-to-date email address because that is your username and how you will be able to access the system.

<u>Students & Parents</u> will receive an email from <u>info@xIntbrain.com</u>. Please click the link to complete your profile.

<u>Students:</u> will need computer access to complete the assessment. Students will be able to update your information and create a unique password. Then watch the informational video and take the quiz. You will then see the link to XLNT Brain Cog Test & a video about test instructions. Please watch the video and complete the XLNT Brain Cog Test. The test will take approximately 35 minutes. Results will be stored in the XLNT Brain database. Depending on the results, students may have to retake the test under supervision at the school.
